Throughout this day steady breeze and clear
weather wind from W. all sail set at
5 a.m. we sight with long island at
2. a.m. we drop anchor by the ~~hundred~~
head and chicken light ship. Saw ~~some~~
several steam and sail vessel going by
end of this day

September the 1st
Wednesday Throughout this day fresh breeze and clear weather
wind from E. all sail set and at 8 a.m.
we took for pilot and drop anchor at
Crewedford at 12 a.m. end of this voyage
