

Schr. "Cameo"

Nov. 28th 1912

Fair and fresh S.W. winds left-
ward at 10:30 AM. in tow make sail
at 3- P.M. off Cuttyhunk and put
to sea under main's jibs & head
sails & pull & by, at 6- Off Romans Land

April 1-12

This day fresh easterly winds gradually
decreasing ship under all sail steering
S.S.E. by compass Lat. by a meridian alt.
39-17 N. Longitude at 4- P.M. 69.30 W
Lat. 38-57 N

April 2-12

This day heavy gales from S.W.
and a terrible swell shorten sail
at 2- P.M. and run E.S.E. until 4- P.M.
heave too under reefed trysails loose
crane and break baree waist and
boarded boats keep filling water
had to stow boat to allow water
to run out

April 3-12

This day strong winds from the
S.W. run E. in morning wind let
go then came from N.W. heavy
swell carried away fore trysail and boat
keep ducking under water now and
then rain in abundance no observation

April 4

This day fresh N.W. wind squally and
rain beginning under trysails at noon
set jibs and jib managed to get
sight in morning and a more
meridian alt. at noon the result was
