

The Camilla Bound out 1867

Sunday July 21st

Lat 35° 25' N Long 69° 44' W The first part of this day squally and rainy with a light breeze from S.W. by the ship weather to S.W. by E. All sail out the middle and latter parts fresh breeze from N. course until 9 AM and the remainder of the day two sails in sight and sounds this day

Monday July 22nd

Lat 35° 04' N Long 69° 52' W Breezy The first part with a squall or two and a fresh breeze from N. The middle and latter parts fine weather with a fresh breeze from N. course E. by S all day All drawing sails set, one sail in sight The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day

Tuesday July 23rd

Lat 35° 12' N Long 69° 44' W Fine weather all this day with the exception of a rain squall or two course E by S All day with a fresh breeze from S.W. All drawing sails set S.W. saw a branch but nothing more. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds.

Wednesday July 24th

Lat 35° 40' N Long 61° 54' W Smoky weather all this day with a good breeze from S.W. course E by S the first part and the middle and latter parts All sail out the watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day

Thursday July 25th

Lat 36° 17' N Long 59° 41' W Smoky The first part with a fresh breeze from S.W. The middle part squally and rainy with a strong breeze from S.W. Double reefed the top sails The latter part thick weather with a strong breeze from S.W. One sail in sight. The second Mate off duty sick. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds

Friday July 26th

Lat 37° 14' N Long 58° 18' W Smoky weather all this day with rain and a fresh breeze from S.W. The first part course S.W. by E. The middle and latter parts course E. by S with a good breeze from S.W. All drawing sails set. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day

Saturday July 27th

Lat 37° 30' N Long 48° 52' W Smoky weather all this day with a good breeze from S.W. course E. by S all day all drawing sails set One sail in sight The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day

Sunday July 28th

Lat 38° 11' N Long 46° 19' W Smoky weather all this day with a good breeze from S.W. course E. by S until 3 AM with the top gallant and main sail in. At 3 AM hauled the fore sail up and luffed to the wind heading to S.W. by E At 6 AM kept off to S.W. and set the fore sail One sail in sight and sounds this day

Monday July 29th

Lat 38° 10' N Long 44° 12' W Fine weather all this day with light breeze from N. course E. by S until 3 AM we then luffed to S.W. with the course up at 6 AM kept off to E. by S again all sail out The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day. The second Mate returned to duty and sounds this day

Tuesday July 30th

Lat 38° 30' N Long 43° 11' W Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The first part course E. by S all sail out At sunset lowered the boats to try the crew. The middle part calm The latter part light breeze from S.W. to N. course E. by S All sail out. Saw black fish. The cooper and carpenter busy The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day

Wednesday July 31st

Lat 38° 30' N Long 41° 19' W Fine weather all this day with the exception of a few showers The wind light and from N. by E course E. by S the first part and the latter part under short sail. The latter part the ship ship steered by the ring and heading for E. by S All sail out. Saw black fish. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds

Thursday August 1st

Lat 38° 10' N Long 39° 39' W Breezy with light rain squalls and a fresh breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the ring and heading S. by E. All day hauled the light sails in the middle part and double reefed the fore top sail in the latter part. The watch employed in ships duty A number of sails in sight and sounds this day
