This day commences with strong breeze from the S. S. E and fine weather middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty so ends this day Steering N. N. W. by compass Lat 27.45

Saturday. 24

This day commences with a strong breeze from the S. S. E middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty so ends this day steering N. N. W. W. by compass lat 26.47

Sunday. 25

This day commences with a strong breeze from S. S. E at seven am. raised the land. Juan. Fernandez bearing N. W. by compass five leagues distance twelve o'clock lowered two boats one to go on and the other to go a fishing there being no recruits the Captain came on board two ships lying in front the steamer California and a english gun boat at three pm made sail at sundown the island in sight bearing S. E four leagues distance steering N. N. W. by compass Lat 25.45 Lon 79.06

Monday 26

This day commences with a light wind from the S. S. E and fine weather middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty so ends this day Steering Lat 21.28 N. N. W. by C

Tuesday. 27

This day commences with light winds and variable middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty so ends this day steering N. N. W. by compass no Observation

Wednesday. 28

This day commences with light trades middle and later part the same crew employed in ship duty Steering N. N. W. by Compass Lat 26.45 Lon 79.54

Thursday. 29

This day commences with strong trades middle and later part the same at five am raised the land bearing N. W. by compass two boats went in shore for fishing came on board at four pm and made sail steering N. W. by N. by compass Lat 20.18
