Friday June 12th 1857

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the S. S. W. ship heading to the S. E. double reefed the fore sails and a small fishing boat and other repairs for whaleing middle part the wind hauled more to the S. W. at daylight saw 2 seals. latter part employed in fishing boat & end Latitude 39.08 Longitude 67.62

Saturday June 13th

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the S. S. W. course S. E. employed in fishing boat middle part pleasant latter part employed in various jobs & sails in sight & end Latitude 38.16 Longitude 67.00

Sunday June 14th

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes and clear weather from the W. S. W. course E. S. E. employed in fishing boat and various other jobs double reefed the top sails middle and latter part much the same & end Latitude 37.30 Longitude 67.07

Monday June 15th

The first part of these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes and clear weather from the W. S. W. course S. E. E. in the fore part squalls with thunder and lightning saw a bird of prey in the latter part squalls with rain so did S. E. E. & end Latitude 36.48 Longitude 67.56

Tuesday June 16th 1857

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes and fair weather with thunder and lightning from the S. S. W. at 5 course E. S. E. at 3 P. M. the weather cleared and hauled more to the S. saw a shoal of porpoises middle part pleasant latter part employed in fishing various scenes Latitude 35.37 Longitude 67.56

Wednesday June 17th

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S. S. W. course E. employed in fishing various and other useful jobs middle part pleasant latter part hauled down our boats and exercised the crews for a half hour came on board and broke out the fore hall after an oak plank & end Latitude 36.42 Longitude 68.50

Thursday June 18th

The fore part of these 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes and pleasant rain weather from the W. S. W. course E. employed in breaking out the fore hall middle part pleasant latter part wind S. E. ship heading E. S. E. employed in fishing various scenes & end Latitude 35.52 Longitude 68.24 Longitude 68.24
