

Bark Canton Packet's Log Book.

Sunday May 12th 1861.

Begins with light breezes and haze from the S.W. ship heading to the S.W. employ in ships day middle part wind shift to the S.E. course S.W. by W. latter part the same
Latitude 33.0 S.
Longitude 68.25 W.

Monday May 13th

Begins with light breezes and pleasant from the S.E. course S.W. by W. employ in ships day middle and latter part much the same
Latitude 33.42 S.
Longitude 69.40 W.

Tuesday May 14th

Begins with light breezes and haze from the S.W. course S.W. by E. employ in ships day middle and latter part pleasant & sail in sight all drawing night set
Latitude 34.38 S.
Longitude 70.30 W.

Wednesday May 15th

Begins with strong breezes and haze from the S.W. course S.W. by W. blowing fresh middle part the same latter part more moderate latter part have the try marks overboard & sail in sight
Latitude 37.09 S.
Longitude 71.31 W.

Thursday May 16th 1861.

Begins with light airs and haze from the E. course S.W. by W. all sail set & rigged the boats and stowed away the craft & sail in sight middle part the same latter part wind S.W. ship heading S.E. Latitude 35.13 S.
Longitude 71.34 W.

Friday May 17th

Begins with moderate breeze and pleasant from the S.W. ship heading to the S.E. employ in ships day middle part much the same latter part heading to the S.E. several sail in sight
Latitude 39.25 S.
Longitude 70.59 W.

Saturday May 18th

Begins with strong breeze and pleasant from the S.W. course S. several sail in sight at 7 P.M. rounded in 68 fathoms water mud cone shelly bottom middle part fresh breeze at midnight wore ship to S.W. latter part at 4 A.M. wore ship to the S.E. several sail in sight
Latitude 40.46 S.
Longitude 70.56 W.
