

Bark Canton Packet's Log Book.

Sunday May 19 1867.

Begins with light airs and pleasant from various quarters course S.W. at 2 P.M. sounded in 20 fathoms water white and black mud at 3 P.M. saw Adams's Sparc bearing S.W. distant 2 leagues bent the cables and got the anchors in the shape's at sundown saw Gay Head bearing N.W. distant 6 leagues middle part at 4 P.M. wind from the N ship heading to the W.S.W. at 4 A.M. wore ship to the S.E. at day light Block Island in sight bearing S.W. distant 5 leagues at 8 A.M. took a Pilot Gay Head and Cuttyhunk in sight bearing S.E. all sail set

Monday May 20 1867

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant from the S.W. steering in for New Bedford at 3 P.M. the Harbour Pilot came on board and proceeded up to the wharf thus ends this voyage of 47 months and 10 days
