 Commences with moderate breeze from the N.W. and thick clouds
 weather ship on the 5th to 6th to 7th under double reefed & Mags
 top 1/2 & single reefed N.W. 7 1/2 M.S. E. & S. from Middle Port fresh
 gales and clouds wind still from the South & latter Part
 moderate wind and clearing N.W. by 7. Long by 15.0.00

Observations on Board Thursday October 6th 1834
 Begins with moderate wind and heavy weather watch
 boys in ship's duty. At P.M. wind light and variable N.W. 1/2
 Part light wind inclining to calm. Latter Part light
 wind 1/2 N.W. wind veering to the E. & S. to the
 ship under all sail to the South. Lat 25.25 N. Long 150.00.00

Observations on Board Friday October 7th 1834
 Commences with light wind from the N.W. and fine weather
 Middle Port fresh breeze and fine weather wind E.S. Latter
 Part strong wind and pleasant Lat 25.30 N. Long 150.00.00
Course true 1/2 E.

Observations on Board Saturday October 8th 1834
 Begins with fine pleasant weather ship under all sail to the
 watch employed in various jobs of ship's duty. At 10 P.M. heft off
 1/2 Mags Middle Port moderate wind and fine weather ship
 under Mags & heft Latter Part light wind from E.S. Lat 26.40 N

Remarks on Board Sunday October 9th 1834
 Begins with light wind from E.S. and fine weather ship
 under all sail to 11.0.00
