Remarks on board Bark Oke Near Pigeon  
Thursday Sep 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part commenced with a calm and heavy swell, employed in various jobs. Middle part strong breeze and rainy. Latter part strong breeze and heavy swell from E heading S.E.

Friday Sep 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part commenced with a strong breeze and clear weather from E heading S.E. employed in various jobs. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part fresh breeze and heavy swell from E.

Saturday Sep 4<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and clear weather from E heading E with a heavy swell, employed in fixing the rigging etc, several sails in sight. Middle part squally. Latter part strong breeze and clear from W.W. steering S.E.

Sunday Sep 5<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and clear weather from W.W. steering S.E. by E. Middle part rainy. Latter part moderate breeze and clear with all sail set

Monday Sep 6<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from W.W. steering S.E. Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part fresh breeze and clear, employed in various jobs

Outward Bound

Tuesday Sep 7<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from W.W. steering S.E. employed in various jobs about the ship. Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part fresh breeze and clear, employed in breaking out provisions

Wednesday Sep 8<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from W.W. steering S.E. by E. fixing the minding box and other jobs. Middle part moderate breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear, repaired the strainer hopper etc

Thursday Sep 9<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with moderate breeze and pleasant weather from W.W. steering S.E. took one of the spare spars off deck and lashed it up alongside of the Foremast, and another alongside of the Main Mast. Middle part moderate breeze, Latter part fresh breeze and clear, working in the rigging etc.

Friday Sep 10<sup>th</sup>

First part commenced with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from W.W. steering S.E. by W. working in the rigging. Middle part fresh breeze, Latter part moderate breeze and clear at 6 A.M. sailed a large Spinn. Whale going quick to the leeward, lowered all the boats and gave chase and at 10 o'clock the Mast Boat struck, took him alongside at 12.
