Saturday August 8 First part of this day
 wind light breeze from the NW set
 the weather clear up we made all
 sails on Port tack. starboard
 light ship, at 7:30 P.M. we anchor on
 Carutino ground saw head of this day
 we take the Pilot off Light Ship, at P.M.
 we anchor in Carutino ground, the costmas
 off came off we went to Wharf saw
 head of this voyage
