Monday July 31 This day very light NE wind and clear atmosphere. Haul under all sails set on Port tack cruising for whales in sight at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to

Tuesday August 1 This day light NE wind and clear atmosphere at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack saw a school of small whale lower three boats did not get any at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to

Lat 37° 15' N Long 72° 40' W

Wednesday August 2 This day light NE wind and clear weather haul under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising at 7 A.M. saw the "Nickerson" and "Nickelson" with boat down chasing whale to the windward we did not lower the boats at sun set we shorting sails Spock to Bertha De Nickerson - bound home with 500 barrels

Thursday August 3 This day very light Easterly wind and clear atmosphere. Haul under all sails set on Starboard tack running off West at 3: P.M. we game with "Elena Sweet" at sun set we shorting sails Spock to five mast Schooner "George P. Hudson" from Portland to Norfolk

Friday August 4 This day light NE wind and clear atmosphere in morning we made all sails on port tack heading N - at 3: P.M. we game with "E. Young" and Spock to five mast Schooner "George P. Hudson" from Portland to Norfolk - at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to

Saturday August 5 This day very light Easterly wind and clear weather haul under all sails set cruising at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to

Lat 37° 35' N Long 72° 39' W

Sunday August 6 This day light Easterly wind and clear atmosphere haul under all sails set on Port tack at 7: A.M. we raised a school of small whale lower three boats L.B. went on whale the boat returned on board Pump attended to

Lat 37° 18' N Long 72° 45' W

Monday August 7 This day fresh Easterly wind and clear at 9: P.M. we sight the "Elena Sweet" with boat down chasing whale we lower three boats we caught 3 L.B. = 1 = S.B. = 1 = W = 1 = We take this whale along side at 2: P.M. we put gears up and start to cutting at 4:30 P.M. we finished cutting and start fire Pump attended to
