Aug:

Wed: 30th 1916 This day began with light breeze and cloudy wind from N. all sails set. Close hauled. Watch employed scrapping Mast. Saw several steamer bound E. pump & side light - Carefully attended. End of day. no observation Sun obscure

Aug:

Thurs: 31st 1916

This day light breeze and fine weather wind from N. all sails set - Course NW by N. Saw steamer bound to NW. Watch employed scrap ship and side and other duty. pump & side light - Carefully attended. End of day.

Lat: 39.33 W.
Lon: 70 06 W.

Sept:

Frid: 1st 1916

This day steady breeze and hazy weather wind from SW all sails set Course NW by N. Saw several steamer by. Watch employed finish painting ~~the~~ rig. & haled the cable rope. Lat 6.30 p.m. sound 33 fathoms. pump & side light - Carefully attended. End of day.

Lat: 40.42 W.
Lon: 71.06 W.

Sept:

Sat: 2nd 1916

This day began with hazy weather wind from SW. all sails set. Last night at 8.30 p.m. we sight light house of Block Island. and we anchor at New Bedford at 9 o'clock p.m. all well board. end of day.
