Saturday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup> 1846

This day commences with moderate winds from S.E. course W by N. heavy showers of rain & sail in sight middle parts the same watch employed in filling up the butt & latter parts took a large tree along side 76 feet long so ends the day

Sunday Jan 4<sup>th</sup> 1846

This day begins with the calm winds & today sail in sight middle parts the same & latter part light winds from E.S.E. course W by N so ends the day

Monday Jan 5<sup>th</sup> 1846

This day commences with moderate winds from the E.S.E. course W by N all hands employed in breaking out the Beef & Pork to expose middle parts the same & sail in sight latter part cloudy so ends the day

Tuesday January 6<sup>th</sup> 1846

This day commences with light winds & calm all hands employed as before stated middle parts the same & latter parts showers of rain so ends the day sail in sight
