Remarks on board of the Bark Catalpa

1 Monday June 23 1856

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather. Course steering S E at 2 commenced lightning latter part the same duced down the fore and main topsails S. ends

2 Tuesday June the 24

These 24 hours commences with squally weather steering S E furled the gill and fly. Gill and double reefed the fore topsail middle part pleasant at woodcock made all sail latter part the same employed in breasting out the main hatch way S ends these 24 hours

3 Wednesday June the 25

These 24 hours commences with a strong breeze course steering E S E employed in showing of the main bottom way at 5 took in the fore utop gallant sail fly gill and gaff topsail Middle part the same took in the main top gallant sail and double reefed the topsails and hauled up the mainsail and furled the gill saw a Brig steering S E by E latter part pleasant made all sail course E S E employed in various gals S ends these 24 hours

4 Thursday June the 26

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather but a heavy swell. Employed in various gals Middle part the same latter part employed in various gals & saw insight S ends
