Journal of a Voyage To the South
 Atlantic Ocean in the Brig Catherwood
 of Westport Commanded by Elisha Cushing
 Commanded with a crew of 22 men all told

Oct Tuesday 12th the Bogies with a light breeze from
 the North at 9 AM took our anchor and toed
 out of the harbour so ends with hard labour

Wed 13th Wednesday 13th the Bogies the same at 10 AM left
 the pilot heading S.W. by S. wind from E.S.E. at
 1 PM saw black island set the watches at 4 sundown
 4 PM at 7 PM at 10 PM at 1 PM at 4 PM at 7 PM at 10 PM
 the middle part a breeze from N.W. at 1 PM saw
 saw black island bore S.W. people employed in fitting
 cutting gear all but so ends this 24 hours

Thurs 14th Thursday 14th Bogies with a fine breeze from N.W.
 Steered S.S.E. people employed in ships duty with
 all hands on deck saw several small sails the middle
 and latter the same double reefed topsails so ends
 Lat by Obs 33-24 N Long by Chron 157-40 West

Friday 15th the Bogies with strong winds steered S.E.
 by E people employed in stripping scrub tees
 the middle and latter part more moderate
 in ships duty set up main top mast fore top
 in topmast stands saw one sail sharp haul on
 the wind steering S.E. by E. N. Lat Long by Chron

Saturday 16th the Bogies with a fine breeze from N.E. by E
 people employed at ships duty broke out after
 hold for sugar and boat craft all hands on deck
 the middle and latter part light breezes
 from N.E. Steered S.E. by S. people employ
 at ships duty with a watch below so ends
 Lat by Obs 35-38 N Long by Chron 153-40 West

Sund 17th the Bogies with pleasant weather people em
 ployed at ships duty Steered S.S.E. breeze from
 N.E. at sundown chose boat crew all sails set as req
 the middle and latter part light breezes from
 N.E. to East three the Night carried double
 reefed topsails at sunrise made all sail at
 seven reefed a gain at 10 made all sail as req
 uired so ends this 24 hours with a strong breeze
 Lat by Obs 34-23 North Long by Chron 152-16 West
