Condition when received: Covers worn and torn, leather rotted, marble sides badly worn, boards loose, spine shaken. Pages worn and torn, soiled, badly stained and damaged by insects.

Work performed: Disassembled book, sterilized and deacidified paper, cleaned pages, reduced stains, mended and guarded and reinforced with Japanese tissue as necessary. Resewed on three hemp cords and rebound in new boards, best calfskin and original marble sides over Japanese paper sides. Replaced original end papers.
