This day began with late wind from S by E
had down of three sails in sideboard & mid all
part late wind at 3 o'clock wind from S by E
ing at 4 o'clock breeze to sails in side saw a
steamer bound to the S by E this day

Lat 33 28 N
Long 76 43 W

Tuesday May 11
This day began with brisk breeze from
S by E at 5 pm saw a bark bound
the same way at 6 pm saw a schooner bound
south strong wind suggest took in the
late sails at 10 o'clock the top sails took in
main sail jib and mid all part strong gales
from south steering at 6 o'clock with a heavy sea
saw north so bound this day suggest

Lat 36 18 N
Long 73 43 W

Wednesday May 12
This day began with heavy gales from the
south steering at 6 o'clock top sails fore sail
at mid night moderate wind from S by E
at day light made all sail steering at 6
saw number of sails seen bound south
saw north so bound strong wind W by S

Lat 38 33 N
Long 72 25 W

Thursday May 13
This day began with more moderate stea-
ring at 6 o'clock wind W by S to W mid all part
the same saw to sails but ten part brisk
breeze from the W steering at 6 o'clock all sail

Lat 40 16 N
Long 72 00 W

Friday May 14
This day began with brisk breeze from
W by S at 4 pm steering at 6 o'clock wind W
mid all part wind at 6 o'clock at 7 o'clock
wind from S had down of late wind at
11 o'clock wind S by W steering at 6 o'clock to S by E

Saturday May 15 1858
This day began with late wind from S by E steering
at 6 o'clock to S by E at 2 pm saw the land
on long island of 16 hours late wind stea-
ring at 6 o'clock
