<p>Tuesday May 1792</p>	<p>First Part of this 24 hours strong wind from the N.W. by N. at 10 o'clock in the main top gallant sail at 2 o'clock in the top sail Middle Part of this 24 hours strong gales with rain Last Part of this 24 hours a strong breeze from the N.W. by N. made all sail set the fore top mast standing sail Lat Long</p>
<p>Wednesday May 1792</p>	<p>First Part of this 24 hours with brisk breeze from the S.W. by W. at 10 o'clock all sail set at 1 o'clock in the top mast standing Middle Part of this 24 hours at 10 o'clock in the top sail Middle Part of this 24 hours from the N.W. by N. at 10 o'clock in the main top gallant sail Lat Long</p>
