

Ship Charley Drew Capt. Coffin sailed ¹⁸⁴⁶ Sept 7th

Monday Sept 7th

We took in at 8 A.M. the mizen topgallant sail and about 10 A.M. we took in foretop gallant sail about 2 P.M. we took in the main topgallant sail at 4 A.M. we reefed the mizen topsail at 5 A.M. we reefed the foretop sail and all hands employe in ships duty. about sundown we lowered the boats to exercise the men in rowing, broke out the main hatch for water, we raised two ships on the lee beam and the other ahead, the wind about S. E. So ends these 24 hours.

Tuesday Sept 8th

The Ships company employe in ships duty we raised a ship larboard beam the wind N. E. So ends this 24 hours.

Wednesday Sept 9th

The Ships company employe in ships duty the Capt. and carpenter making a potatoe pen the wind N. W. So ends these 24 hours.

Thursday Sept 10th

On the day laying to in a gale of wind on a close reef main topsail foretopmast staysail and fore and main spencer, saw a ship hove to at the seaward at 6 o'clock P.M. carrill away our main spencer gale wind N. by E.

So ends this 24 hours

Friday Sept 11th

On this day the hands were employe in ships duty raised a sail on the lee quarter wind N. E.

So ends these 24 hours

Saturday Sept 12th

All hands employe in ships duty about 9 A.M. saw a ship on our lee beam in the afternoon starboard watch employe in setting up fore topmast and topgallant rigging the wind about W. by N.

So ends these 24 hours.

Sunday Sept 13th

We took in topgallant sail at two A.M. and broke out our main hatch for water at 3 A.M. we doubled reefed our foretop sail for and aft we saw 2 ships in the night on the larboard on the larboard bow the larboard tackes aboard we wer steering E. by S. the wind N. by W.

So ends these 24 hours

Monday Sept 14th

The watch was busy at ships duty and the carpenter was to work on the potatoe pen and we shook out the topsail and loosed topgallant sails fore and aft we saw a ship on the lee beam about 6 P.M. wind about N. N. W. Steering E.

So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Sept 15th

All hands employe in ships duty, in the afternoon the weather was thick and cloudy took in all sail except close and reef main topsail and fore topmast staysail the wind being W. by S.

So ends these 24 hours
