Com<sup>d</sup> with  
fine weather one watch on liberty

Monday Oct the 8<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
light breeze of shore at 1 PM got under  
way bound to Moakoo at 4 PM double  
reefed the topsails middle and latter  
part strong breeze

Tuesday Oct the 9<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
strong breeze from the N.E. bying  
of land on at Moakoo at 1 PM the boat  
went on shore

Wednesday Oct the 10<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
strong breeze from the N.E. heading  
by the wind N.E. at 7 PM the boat  
came on board at 8 PM on board the  
mainsail

Thursday Oct the 11<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
light breeze from the N.E. heading  
by the wind N.E. at 11 PM bent the  
mainsail middle and latter part  
fine weather with a strong breeze

Friday Oct the 12<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
strong breeze from the N.E. steering  
E.S.E. at 10 PM shortened sail at 4 PM

became calm middle and latter part  
calm and pleasant weather

Saturday Oct the 13<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a strong  
strong breeze from the N.E. steering by  
the wind N.E. at 6 PM double reefed the  
top sails steering S.E. by S with a  
strong breeze

Sunday Oct the 14<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
strong breeze from the N.E. steering  
S.E. by S under double reefed top-sail  
middle part the same latter part  
more moderate at 6 PM tarred the reefs  
out of the fore and main topsails

Monday Oct the 15<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a  
fine breeze from the N.E. steering S.E. by  
S. at 9 PM tarred the reefs out of the  
mizzen topsails and top-gallant sail  
middle and latter part fine and  
pleasant weather under all sail

Tuesday Oct the 16<sup>th</sup>  
Com<sup>d</sup> with a fine  
breeze from the N.E. steering S.E. by S.  
with pleasant weather under all sail  
middle and latter part moderate  
breeze at 11 PM hauled to the Mast &  
tacked ship to E.S.E. with light  
squalls of rain
