Remarks on board Saturday Sept 5th 1846
Comd with fresh gales S by W & fine weather
all sail set course E by S all hands employed
various ways breaking out for water &c

Wind much the same

Later strong breeze S by S broke out the
run &c
Lat 39 35 Long 46 16

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 6th

First part wind S by S course E by S

Wind nine easter to W

Later wind the same all arising sail set
Lat 39 23 Long 39 32

Remarks on board Monday Sept 7th
First part fine breeze at W & pleasant weather
course E by S

Wind wind shifted to N & squally reefs fore & main
top

Later wind NE & squals of rain watch employ
various ways
Lat 39 52 Long

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 8th
First light wind NE by the wind E by S broke out
for water. at 5 PM lowered the boats to practice

Wind fresh gales E by S & squally

Later about the same steering by the wind
Lat 39 24 Long 53 23

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Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 9th 1846
Comd with light winds at N & E and cloudy
watch employ making scrub broom & one sail
in sight

Wind about the same

Later light wind at N course E by S
Remarks on board Thursday Sept 10th
Comd light wind at W course E by S
Lat 39 38 Long

Wind wind shifted sudden to the N & E and increas
ed to a gale with some rain & lightning reduced
sail till under close reefed M. top & foresail
Later strong gales & cloudy going too one sail
off the boom sheaving to the E. Lat 39 12 Long 48 25

Remarks on board Friday Sept 11th
First part gale wind N & E under short sail
headed to the E the sail stick in sight

Wind about the same further the foresail ship head
ing E & S
Later wind N with heavy squalls attended with
a little rain one sail in sight Lat 39 31

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 12th
Wind & weather about the same the sail to be
ward

Wind much the same
Later more moderate set tops & courses
Lat 39 23 Long 46 26

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 13th
Moderate breeze at W course E by S watch employ
pulling up rigging the bark stick in sight to Centre
Wind strong gales N by W passed two sail

Later about the same with squals of rain broke
out for water double reefed tops &c
Lat 39 40 Long 43 8
