 Monday April 16<sup>th</sup> 1849  
 Light trades ESE & fine weather course at W & N  
 Mill & Latten the same Lat 16 23

Tuesday April 17<sup>th</sup>  
 Modt trade NE Mill & Latten do painting span  
 at 12 noon smart shower of rain saw a Bark steering  
 to the N. No Obs

Wednesday April 18<sup>th</sup>  
 Comes in with moderate trades NE & fine weather  
 painting span Mill & Latten the same Lat 17 27

Thursday April 19<sup>th</sup>  
 Light trades from the E painted & sanded  
 the cabin spoke the brig Conguwar of Glasgow  
 bound to Jamaica & got a bbl of potatoes Ma  
 & Latten the same Lat 20 37

Friday April 20<sup>th</sup>  
 Light trades & fine weather Mill & Latten do  
 two sail in sight steering to the N Lat 22 33

Saturday April 21<sup>st</sup>  
 Light trades SE & fine weather steering at N & N  
 Mill do Latten much the same Lat 23 39

Sunday April 22<sup>d</sup>  
 Light winds SE & pleasant Mill & Latten  
 strong breeze N. tacked to N & W saw a bark head  
 ing to the E Lat 25 15 60 15

Monday April 23<sup>d</sup>  
 Fresh gales NE & cloudy by the wind at W  
 one sail in sight Mill & Latten do Lat 26 21

Tuesday April 24<sup>th</sup>  
 Fresh gales NE took in the light sails. opened  
 all the & fresh Mill do Latten wind came to the  
 E. with light squalls of rain one sail in sight  
 Lat 28 2 64 6

Wednesday April 25<sup>th</sup>  
 Fresh gales E. course at W & SE. Mill do  
 Latten light winds NE & pleasant washed  
 ship a bark in sight steering to the N.  
 Lat 29 38

Towards Home Homeward bound  
 Thursday April 26<sup>th</sup> 1849  
 Light winds NE & pleasant steering NE & N  
 E. Ma & Latten light breeze SE all hatches paint  
 ing ship outside & in Lat 30 31

Friday April 27<sup>th</sup>  
 Light breeze ESE & fine weather finished painting  
 Mill much the same Latten calm putting on  
 the second coat inside two sail in sight  
 Lat 31 35

Saturday April 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Light winds from SE to NE & pleasant three  
 sail in sight course at N & W. Ma & Latten do  
 Lat 32 29

Sunday April 29<sup>th</sup>  
 Light breeze S & fine weather course at N & W  
 Ma & Latten wind S & W & cloudy saw a bark  
 bound S. No Obs

Monday April 30<sup>th</sup>  
 Fresh gales SW & some rain passed the ship with  
 us of heading by the wind to the S Lat 34 50 Long  
 69 Mill calm Latten fresh gales NE & rainy saw  
 a bark steering to the S Lat 35 60 76 16

Tuesday Apr 30<sup>th</sup>  
 Wind came to the S & moderate made all sail course  
 at N & W. Ma much the same Latten light & flying  
 winds, calm & rainy in the southern edge of the gulf  
 water 76

Wednesday May 2<sup>d</sup>  
 Light wind, calm & some rain Ma much the same  
 Latten fresh gales NE by the wind at W took in  
 the light sails several vessels in sight Lat 38 35

Thursday May 3<sup>d</sup>  
 Fresh gales NE & two barks in sight Ma & Latten  
 light wind & calm several sails in sight Lat 39 17

Friday May 4<sup>th</sup>  
 Light breeze SE steering NE & several vessels in  
 sight at 4 P.M. saw the two barks overboard Ma do  
 Latten strong breeze SE at 9. A.M. spoke the pilot  
 boat of the Fisheries of St. John at 12 made long tacks  
 at 5 took a pilot of black skin pulled along the coast  
 of Brazil
