

At St. Michaels,

Barth Charles W. Morgan, Capt. Vindlow

Tuesday Oct 19, 1875

This day begins with strong wind from the W. With plenty of rain, middle part raining hard. Last night one man ran away - 18 all together. The Bark - Johnson, West arrived, in port. Crew busy unmooring the vessel and getting ready for sea at 2 P.M. Was unmoored and lines cut ready for hauling out, at 1/2 past 5, made sail and went out side to lay off and on. Strong breeze all night. Only 12 men including all hands on board the capt and wife on shore. So ends

Wednesday Oct 20

This day begins with strong breeze from the W. With heavy S.W. running middle part the same. At 2 P.M. sent a boat on shore for the capt but he did not come. at 6 P.M. saw Capt Vindlow going on board, at his ship to go to sea. at 7 P.M. Capt Binkum and wife came on board at 8 P.M. the capt went on shore to get men got one, and came on board and kept off for St. Michaels, for men. With light winds, middle part frozen up. So ends this day

Thursday Oct 21.

This day begins with moderate winds from the W. Steering S. by W. at day light raised the land and after breakfast, lashed the Starboard boat, and the capt went on shore after men. Staped Mutt after dark, and stole 4 and a fox. middle part moderate weather. latter part the same Steading S. by W. So ends this day.
