

Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan of

Tuesday July 19th

This begins with fresh breeze and rain in the first part of the day middle & latter part fine breeze from S. and S.W. Steered E.S.E. Spoke Schooner Franklin of New Bedford

Spoke Franklin Schooner about latter

Wednesday July 20

Light breeze and pleasant all this day and Bark steering E.S.E. with all sails out saw one Schooner heading to North

Thursday July 21st

This day commences with light breeze from S. and Bark steering S.E. by E. in the latter calm and heavy swell from S. the crew employed in felling rigging

Friday July 22^d

This begins with fresh breeze from S. in the first part of the day in latter part strong breeze and rugged Bark Steered E. by S. and E.S.E. and S.E. by E.

Saturday July 23^d

Fresh breeze from S.W. in the first of the day and Bark steering S.E. by E. we saw whaler heading to N.W. but we did not speak in the latter part the same at 2 P.M. raised school whales we saw three boats but no chance took in sails

Sunday July 24th

Strong breeze from S.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part moderate and steering by the wind heading about S.S.E. and then E.S.E. with main top gallant out and fly jib took sails
Lat. 37-00 Long. 48-40

Monday July 25th

Light breeze from S.W. at daylight we made sails and steered by the wind heading about S.E. by E. with all sails out saw two merchant ships heading to eastward and square heads grampus in the latter part quiet moderate took in sails at dusk

Tuesday July 26th

Light breeze from S. in first part of the day we to eastward saw two vessels heading about the same in the latter part calm

Wednesday July 27th

Calm in the first part of this day and middle part the same in the latter part light air from N.E. and ship heading about E. saw one vessel steering to S.E.

Thursday July 28th

This day commences with light air from N.E. in the first part of the day and ship heading about N.N.W. with all sails out we saw one vessel heading to N.W. in the latter fine breeze from the same

Friday July 29th

Calm all this day and very smooth air saw steamer and one brig and we are making a top sail upper top part to main

Saturday July 30th

Light breeze from N.W. in the first part of the day Bark heading about E.S.E. saw three vessels in the latter part strong breeze and squally at 5.30 took in all sails but lower main top sail and close reef fore top sail
