Onboard Bark Cicew

I begin to write in this book to day Sunday
Dec 12, 1880. Very pleasant weather. Observed
some Almon tried to extract a tooth for
Will Winslow but failed. The third mate
saw something about 3/4 miles away but
have seen nothing more of it.
Saw a Lopez head turtle in the crates
Had a short nap this afternoon. Com-
menced a letter to Annie

Mon
Dec 13

Cut out three calico shirts to give to the officers
made two this morning at 11 A.M. one of
the pigs had three little ones. Almon brought
one below and put in the bed with me. Almon
been to Mast head two hours.

Tues
Dec 14

Made one calico shirt, cut two more out &
made them. Almon been to mast head
two hours. Saw a seal of the Lee Bow which
proved to be an English Man of War. Caught
a large dolphin & we been out on deck to
see it. It been out in the Star board boat
Augustus Gomez saw a white water, the
Mate went aloft & pronounced it porpoise 1/2
miles off. been in the mast to feed the hens
one I am petting & we named Hannah. The little
pig Almon has named. Turkey, Moody, &
Victoria Woodhull. Moody we are going to make
a pet of. we had it in the house 1/2 hour this
afternoon laying on the ~~floor~~. To night
we broken the lamp chimney

Wed
Dec 15

Washed our clothes. Almon been to mast
head two hours. Mended night dress. Basted
one undershirt. Basted one chemise. Almon
played on his violin & harmonica. Been so
warm this afternoon I could not sit in the
house with the windows & door open. go sat in
the cabin with all the side lights open.
The Michel taken sick this fore vomiting
& pain in his bowels.
