

Journal on board Ship Addition of St. Breyer

Tuesday At 10 A.M. came aboard & got under
weigh in charge of a Pilot & came
down the Bay with light breeze from
N. E. —

Wednesday
26th Comes in with moderate breeze from
N. E. & bearing to the S. E. with some
W. — At 1 P.M. the Pilot left near
the Lion & Reg.

Middle & Latter parts stormy with
wind from S. E. to S. W. wore ship
at 1 A.M. to the S. E. crew most
all sea-sick, under double reefed
topsails & courses most all night.

Long — $70^{\circ} 33' W$ —

Thursday
27th All of this 24 hours fresh breeze from
N. W. & pleasant. Course S. E. & S. E. by
E. — in the evening double reefed the
topsails & stowed topgallants.

All hands able to work employed
in clearing up — So ends

Lat Obs $38^{\circ} 14' N$ —

Long 7 P.M. Obs $68^{\circ} 57' W$

Friday
28th First part moderate breeze from
N. W. Course S. E. & E. with all useful
sail set. —

Middle & Latter parts much the
same — Turned the Cook forward for
his fittness & put a hand in his
place — Middle & Latter parts more
moderate the wind bearing to the S. E.
gradually —
