

1856 Ship Addison Outward Bound.

Saturday
Nov 29th First part fresh breeze from N.W. -
& pleasant m. Course S.E. by E. passed
a herm by. Middle & latter parts
more moderate & veering to the S.E.
turned our cook out of the Galley
& put in a hand. - *Big Fox*

Sunday
30th Comes in with moderate breeze from
S.E. & veering gradually to the S. -
steering by the wind to the Sth at 1
P.M. wore to the Eth at 4th squally
in the light sails & soon after double
reefed the Toppails. At 8th wind strong
from S.W. & squally - Course E. by S. by S.
took in jib & mainsail. M. & latter
parts strong gale from N.W. & veering
under double reefed fore & m. Toppails &
Fore Course

Monday All of this day strong gale from N.W. & squally
Dec 1st & squally Course E. S. E. Course as
above. Saw a *Big* hove to.

2nd E. by S. by S.

Lat Obs. 33° 53'
Long Obs. 52° 10'

Papaya Out. Decr 1856

Monday All of this day hard gale from N.W. & squally
Wednesday Course E. S. E. under double reefed Toppails
3rd & Fore Course - Shipping some water amid
ship as there is a bad sea running.
Latter part course E.

Lat Obs. 33° 33'
Long Obs. 48° 22'

Thursday First part more moderate but squally from
4th N.W. set whole Toppails mainsail & m.
topgallant - Course E. M. part wind
freshened - furled topgallant & double
reefed the Toppails. Latter part more
moderate though still a strong breeze -
made all sail. Wind N. Course E.
S. E.

Lat Obs. 33° 30' N.
Long Obs. 45° 10' W.

Friday First part strong wind from N. with passing
5th clouds Course E. S. E. with all sail set
Middle & latter part strong winds & gradually
increasing - took in topgallant.

Lat Obs. 33° 35'
Long Obs. 41° 38'

Saturday Comes in with a strong gale from N. & squally
6th at 1 P.M. shortened sail to a close reefed
M. Toppail double reefed Fore do. & Fore Course
Course S. E. by E. Hoisted the boats to the
stain heads. - Shipping some water - saw a
good deal of gale - mud.
M. & latter parts blowing heavy with heavy squalls.
