from S. E. and good weather course
S. W. by N Mid the same latter
part Late Winds from S. E. Course
Lat by obs 20-10 N Long 38-00
West So Ends these 24 hours

Tuesday, March 6th
Passes with Light Winds from
S. E. and fine weather, all sail
out course S. W. by N Saw a
Big Standing to Eastward Lat
21-39 N Long 60-22 West

Wednesday, March 7th
Came in with Light Airs from
S. E. course S. W. Mid calm
Men employed Tainting their
latter part Late Winds from S. W.
Braced up Sharp Standing to
Northward Lat 22-45 Long 61-21
West So Ends these 24 hours

Thursday, March 8th
Came in with Light Winds from
S. W. and fine weather Braced
up Sharp Heading to Northward
6 A.M. were Ship's Heading West
Mid and latter part the same
Lat by obs 23-50 N Long 61-43 West
So Ends these 24 hours

Friday, March 9th 1860
Passes with good weather and
calm Lat 23-50 North Long
63-08 West West So ends these 24 hours

Saturday, March 10th
First Part of these 24 hours
calm Mid Late Winds from S. W.
latter part Fresh Breezes and
good weather course S. W. by N
Lat 24-34 N Long 63-53 West

Sunday, March 11th
Came in with ~~light~~ good weather
and a good breeze from S. W.
course S. W. by N Mid and latter
part Wind S. W. and very good
under Dub, Ruffs Heading to
Northward do do So ends these 24 hours

Monday, March 12th
First Part Fresh Breezes from
S. W. under Dub and Ruffs Heading to
Northward 6 A.M. Wind S. W. Saw
Ship's Heading of to Westward on the Wind
Mid and latter part Late Winds and
good weather Lat by obs 27-30 North
Long 65-41 West So ends these 24 hours
