we had filled up our cask which is about 500 lbs
but our fifth of that I should feel thankful.

Sunday 8th

Weather good and small birds in sight

Monday 9th

The same no whale but we are expecting to see
soon North Head in sight

Tuesday 10th weather good commenced with Sir
Helen and 32 lb. Arsenic

Wednesday 11th weather good Bank in view
of a 1000 lbs oil to enough to make up a thousand
on Board

Thursday 12th weather good

Friday 13th Spoke Bank I saw a woman Ray Master

Saturday 14th steering oil and we feel thankful

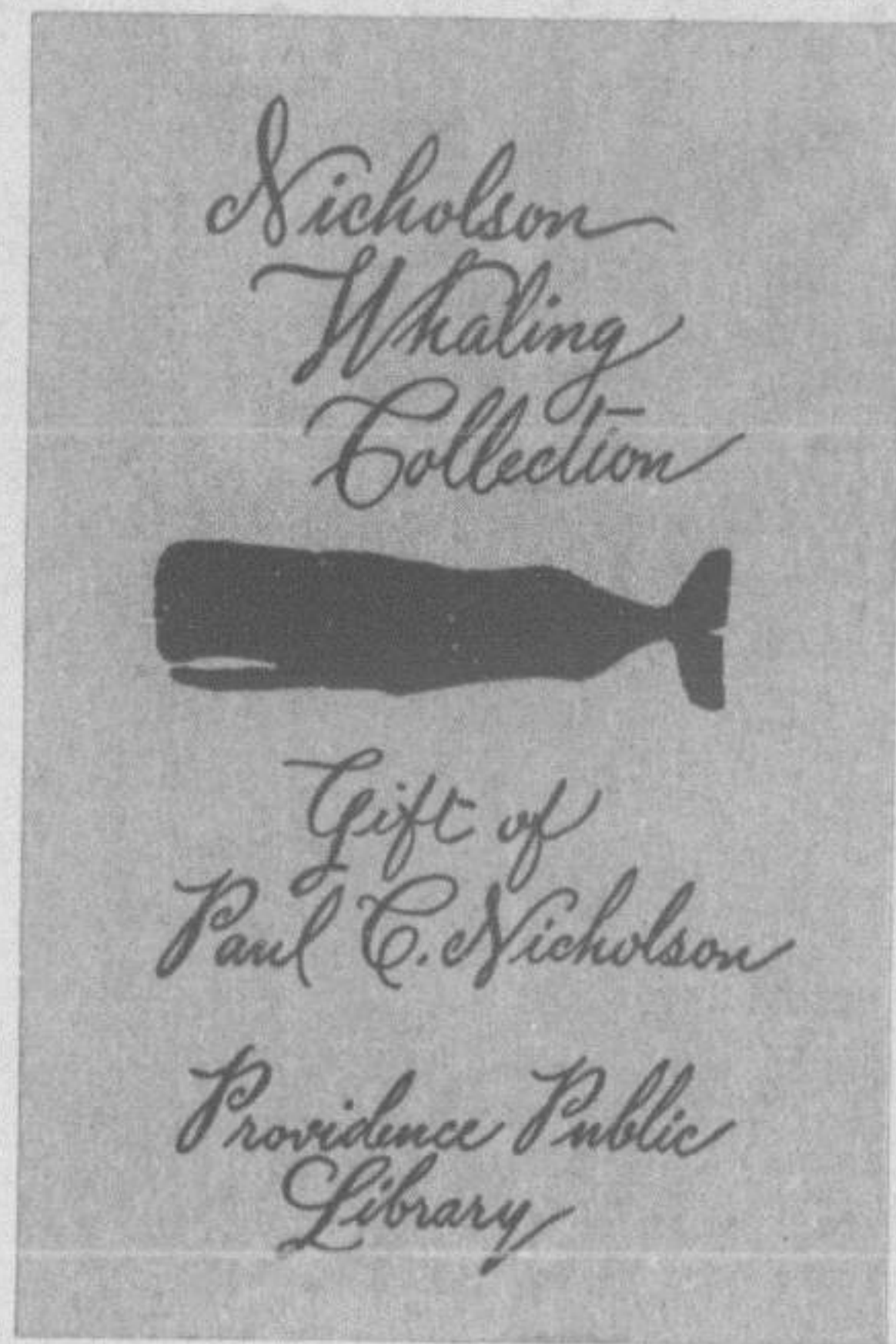
Sunday 15th finished and a regulated thing a little
