

Remarks on board Schooner L. Sparks

Saturday May 6

This day begins with light winds from the S. middle part now breeze all hands to work on the boats latter part calm took in sail at sundown Lat 34.45 Lon 70.31

Sunday May 7

This day commences with light winds from the S. middle part little more breeze from the westward hoisted the main sail at 3 P.M. steering SSW one sail in sight steering to the southward so ends this day Lat 34.25 Lon 70.00

Monday May 8

This day begins with light winds from the Southward and westward steering to the southward saw a school of Porpoises Lat 33.43 Lon 69.18

Tuesday May 9

This day commences with light winds from the SW made sail at daylight at 2 P.M. tacked to the westward saw a lot of Furbacks in sight Lat 33.19 Lon 69.07

Wednesday May 10

This day begins with light winds middle part strong breeze from the SSW at 11.30 reefed the foresail so ends this day Lat 33.01 Lon 69.00

Thursday May 11

This day begins with light winds from the West middle part calm Furbacks Porpoises and Grampuses and one Bark Lat 32.40 Lon 69.40

Friday May 12

This day begins with light winds from the ENE running to the SSW two sails in sight and a school of Blubber Lat 31.45 Lon 71.00

Saturday May 13

This day begins with light winds from the S. saw a lot of Porpoises Lat 30.30 Lon 71.14

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Sunday May 14

This day begins with light westerly winds latter part calm one Bark and one Schooner in sight steering to the Southward Lat 29.38 Lon 74.04

Monday May 15

This day begins with fresh breezes from the N. with rain latter part more moderate now ship and stood to the N. Lat 28.36 Lon 74.40

Tuesday May 16

This day begins with light winds from the eastward running to the N. one schooner in sight steering to the S. Lat 29.12 Lon 72.28

Wednesday May 17

This day begins with light winds from the eastward with rain latter part more moderate one Bark in sight and a school of Porpoises Lat 30.00 Lon 73.00

Thursday May 18

This day begins with light easterly winds latter part calm one sail in sight bound to the westward so ends this day Lat 29.54 Lon 73.27

Friday May 19

This day begins with light winds from the eastward broke out the hole and bent the old main sail and Flying jib and set up the fore topmast rigging so ends this day Lat 29.30 Lon 74.01
