

Remarks on board the Oliva & Sparks

Saturday May 6

This day begins with light winds from the S.E. middle part more breeze all hands to work on the boats latter part calm took in sail at sunset Lat 34.43 Lon 70.81

Sunday May 7

This day commences with light winds from the S.E. middle part little more breeze from the westward hoisted the mainail at 8 AM steering SSW no sail in sight steering to the southward as it was this day Lat 34.25 Lon 70.00

Monday May 8

This day begins with light winds from the southward and westward steering to the southward saw a school of Porpoises Lat 33.43 Lon 68.18

Tuesday May 9

This day commences with light winds from the SW made sail at daylight at 2 AM tacked to the westward saw a lot of Tubbacks in sight Lat 33.12 Lon 67.00

Wednesday May 10

This day begins with light winds middle part strong breeze from the SSW at 11.30 after the forenoon we cross this day Lat 33.01 Lon 67.00

Thursday May 11

This day begins with light winds from the N.W. made sail saw Tubbacks Porpoises and Grampus over one Bark Lat 32.40 Lon 67.40

Friday May 12

This day begins with light winds from the ENE running to the SSW two sails in sight and a school Bladd Lat 31.45 Lon 67.00

Saturday May 13

This day begins with light winds from the S.E. saw a lot of Porpoises Lat 30.30 Lon 67.14

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Sunday May 14

This day begins with light easterly winds latter part calm one Bark and one Sled in sight steering to the Southward Lat 29.88 Lon 70.04

Monday May 15

This day begins with fresh breezes from the N.E. with rain latter part more moderate now ship and stood to the N.W. Lat 28.36 Lon 70.40

Tuesday May 16

This day begins with light winds from the eastward running to the N.W. one sail in sight steering to the S.E. Lat 27.12 Lon 72.25

Wednesday May 17

This day begins with light winds from the eastward with rain latter part more moderate one Bark in sight over a school of Porpoises Lat 26.80 Lon 73.00

Thursday May 18

This day begins with light easterly winds latter part calm one sail in sight bound to the westward as ends this day Lat 27.54 Lon 73.27

Friday May 19

This day begins with light winds from the eastward broke out the hole and bent the old mainsail and Flying jib and set up the fore topmast rigging as ends this day Lat 27.30 Lon 74.01
