

Log Book of D.K. Clarice, (C.M. Merchant, Capt)

Nov 2^d 1875 Commences with Moderate breezes
from N.W. at 8 O'clock A.M. took anchor
and started for Vineyard Sound
at 2 P.M. bore away for Edgartown
Wind blowing fresh gale from N.W.
at 4 P.M. anchored giving her both anchors
and Capt. Merchant went ashore leaving
Ship in charge of Mr. Simpson Pilot
all hands being on board The following persons
