Nov 3rd

at 9 A.M. Sea acct weighed anchor
and stood out to sea wind moderate
and baffling from North to West
to South

Nov 4th

These 24 hours commences with
with light winds from North and West
Bk standing out to sea at 1/2 past 3 P.M.
Pilot left ship having passed outer
Reef secured Anchorage and ~~secured~~
the Watches made part light wind
from West S. West Bk steering S by E
Leather part Wind N.E. and Rainy
Employed Coiling lines

Thursday
Friday

comes in with light & Easterly
winds and Rainy Ship steers S by E. Watch
Employed with Ship duties at 5 P.M.
Shortened sail Double Reefed Top sails
put Boats on upper Crum Battered down
Hatches and sent all hands to Supper
Wind blowing fresh from N.N.E.
Ship steers S by E. Middle part strong
Winds and Ruffled Leather part more obscured
Ship steers S by E Employed getting boats
ready No Observations

Sat. Nov 6th

These 24 hours comes in with moderate
weather and equally all hands employed
getting boats ready for Whaling at 6 P.M. Ship
steers by the Wind to the S.E. East light winds
and Rainy Middle part fresh gale from
N.E. Bk lying to under Close Reefed
Main Top sail
Leather part more moderate Wind to
Easterly Bk steers S by E made more
sail one sail on sight

Remarks on Bk Clarice of Edgartown (Marchant),
Sunday Nov 7th 1875

Began with strong breezes from N.N.E.
Bk steers S by E the Man hoisted Rick and
off Duty one sail on sight to leeward
Middle and Latter part very much the
same Employed getting Custom gear
Leath 37, 45, 11. Long 66, 46, 41 up

Monday Nov 8th

Commences with fresh breezes from
N.N.E. Bk steering S by E. All hands employe
getting up Custom gear the Man hoisted
Rick and off Duty
Leath 36, 20 Middle part strong winds from N.E.
Long 63, 35 Latter part blowing a gale from same
quarters Bk under short sail

Tuesday 9th

Begins with fresh gale from N.E.
Leath 36, 20 Bk by the wind on foot back Middle and
Long 63, 35 Latter part same

Wednesday 10th

Begins with more moderate
weather wind N.E. made sail Bk steers
35, 0 S by E. Employed getting boats ready
62, 28 making vice bench & E
Middle part fine breezes from N.N.E. Course
S by E. Latter part variable winds
(light) Bk pointing to the Eastward
Watch Employed with Ship duties

Thursday Nov 11th

These 24 hours comes in with
light variable winds Bk working to
the Eastward Watch Employed with
Ship Duties Middle part fine breezes from
S.S.W. Course E.S.E. under all sail
Latter part very much the same all hands
breaking out, mending fore topmast stay
sail & E
