

Bound To The Eastward 1854

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Wednesday September 27th
Begins with light breeze from S & hauling it E by E and
about ship. Alls Mandel New Bedford middle and last
part strong breeze and plenty of rain at 4. Sails were still
hauling down. Last part weather about the same.
By Jac Lat 46.00 Long 164.00

Thursday Sept 28th
Begins with strong breeze from ESE with plenty of rain
hauling down with a heavy swell coming from the southward
at 10 P. No more ship hauling ESE last part light wind and drifting
attended with rain two sails in sight Lat 46.19 Long 165.00

Friday Sept 29th
Begins with light breeze from NNE steering ESE at 4 P.M.
wind hauls NNE at night blows fresh in squalls last
part light gales from NNE and pleasant weather
Lat 45.00 Long 168.48

Saturday Sept 30th
Begins with pleasant breeze from NNE steering SE by E
with all sail set ship. Alls Mandel remains in sight
at night heavy squalls and plenty of rain. Last part
strong gales Lat 45.50 Long 172.19

Sunday Oct 1st
Begins with fresh gales from NNE steering ESE with all
sail set at night took in gallant sails last part weather
about the same Lat 42.18 Long 175.45

Monday October 2nd
Begins with light gales from the northward
steering E by S with gallant sails set last part
moderate breeze from SE heading ESE
Lat 41.15 Long 178.55
