Tuesday Oct 3

Begins with light breeze from N<sup>W</sup> heading E S E  
employed cutting a new main topmast staysail over  
middle and last winds baffling with heavy puffs  
Lat 59° 55' Long 179° 10' 00"  
Barometer 1/4 points better

Wednesday Oct 4

Begins with baffling winds from N<sup>W</sup> middle  
and last part heavy gales from East  
Lat 58° 35' Long 179° 20'

Thursday Oct 5

Begins with baffling winds from the Eastward  
heading S E with double reef topsails set  
last part fresh gales from S E with plenty of rain  
No Obs By Sec Lat 58° 40' Long 177° 00'

Friday Oct 6

Begins with fresh gales from S E and plenty  
at 4 P.M. took in sail blows on heavy in  
squalls at 12 wind hauled west hup off East last part  
calm with a heavy swell on  
Lat 58° 48' Long 176° 48'

Saturday Oct 7

Begins with calm weather at night strong breezes  
from N<sup>W</sup> steering East with all sail set  
last part light breeze from N<sup>W</sup> Lat 58° 20' Long 174° 00'

Sunday Oct 8

Begins with light breezes from N<sup>W</sup> at night  
blows fresh double reef the topsails saw  
a school of blackfish lower did not get fast  
last part heavy gales from N<sup>W</sup> steering  
S E with close reef topsails set  
Lat 57° 18' Long 172° 20'

Bound Eastward 1854

Monday October 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with heavy gales from N<sup>W</sup> with a heavy  
sea running steering S E with close reef topsails set  
middle gale abated last part calm Lat 86° 08' Long 169° 50'

Tuesday Oct 10

Begins with calm weather a heavy swell on  
last part weather the same on bent the main sail  
repaired it Lat 85° 33' Long 169° 05'

Wednesday Oct 11

Begins with calm weather on bent the main topsails  
repaired it last part calm saw a school of  
blackfish lower got two Lat 85° 30' Long 168° 45'

Thursday Oct 12

Begins with calm weather at night light breezes  
from the Eastward with plenty of rain last  
part fresh breezes from S E and clear weather  
Lat 85° 44' Long 167° 32'

Friday Oct 13

Begins with fresh breezes from S E heading E S E  
with all sail set hauled out the blackfish last  
part heavy squalls and plenty of rain wind hauled  
to the Northward Ends N's Observation  
By Sec Lat 86° 10' Long 165° 10'

Saturday Oct 14

Begins with fresh breezes from the Northward and  
squally weather steering East Lat 85° 48' Long 162° 01'

Sunday Oct 15

Come with fresh breezes from N<sup>W</sup> heading E by S middle  
and last part light baffling winds and plenty  
of rain  
No Observation  
By Sec Lat 85° 11' Long 160° 11'
