

Remained on board Bark Vera. Bound on Whaler voyage

Friday May 17th 1839

Fore part light breeze at board our W Boat and
got 1 Bbl fish Middle part light breeze steering E
Per compass at 10 A.M. saw a school of Spinn Whales
all 3 boats got fast light breeze Lat 36.05 Long 68.30

Saturday May 18th 1839

Fore part light breeze at 3 P.M. got 4 Whales along
side ~~at 7 A.M.~~ ~~at 7 A.M.~~ ~~at 7 A.M.~~
at 7 A.M. commenced cutting latter part the breeze
increasing at noon got 3 of them cut in Lat 35.43 Long 68

Sunday May 19th 1839

Fore part brisk breeze from the S.W. at 4 P.M. finish
cutting at 11.30 P.M. the wind hauls to the N.W.
brisk gale latter part brisk gale and clear heading
westward Lat 36.12 Long 67.30

Monday May 20th 1839

Fore part the wind moderated at 2 P.M. commenced
boiling Middle part strong breeze from S.W. steering
E & E Per compass latter part strong breeze steering E
Per compass Lat 36.01 Long 66.42

Tuesday May 21st 1839

Fore part strong breeze from S.W. steering E by S Per
compass employed in boiling at 7 A.M. finished with
roald away 56 Bbls latter part strong breeze steering
East Per compass Lat 36.04 Long 64.42

Wednesday May 22nd 1839

All this day strong strong breeze from
W.S.W. steering East Per compass
Lat 36.05 Long 61.55

Fore part strong breeze from S.W. steering East Per compass
middle and latter part strong breeze from S.W. steering East
Employed in Spewing down Oil Lat 36.35 N
Long 59.25 W

Friday 24th

These 24 hours commenced with strong breeze from S.W.
steering East Per compass middle part strong breeze and
squally at 1 A.M. took in the top galantails and
double reef the top sails steering East Per compass
latter part more moderate at 10 A.M. made all sail
Lat 36.54 N
Long 56.43 W

Saturday 25th

Commenced with strong breeze from S.W. steering East
Per compass with all sail set at 4 P.M. the wind
from S.E. steering by the wind to E.N.E. middle part
strong breeze latter part light breeze from S.E. heading E.N.E.
Lat 35.63 N
Long 55.28 W

Sunday 26th

Fore part strong breeze light breeze from S.W.
steering. E by South middle part light air and calm
latter part the same Lat 38.36 N
Long 54.42 W

Monday 27th

Commenced with light breeze from S.W. steering
E by South with all sail set middle part strong breeze
at 10 P.M. took in the 5th mast standing sail at 12 o'clock
took in fore and main top galantails at 1 A.M.
double reef top sails at 7.7 A.M. the wind from
W.N.W. and moderated made all sail 20 ends
Lat 39.35 N
Long 51.68 W

Tuesday 28th

Fore part a breeze from W.N.W. steering E by S Per
compass with all sail set middle and latter
part light breeze from W.N.W. steering E by S Per compass
Lat 38.22 N
Long 48.52 W
