on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean
Capt. Nicholas Baker

- 1 Thursday Sept 2^d 1841. At 10 A.M. got under
weigh with a fine breeze from the South.
- 2 Friday 3^d Employed beating out of the Bay the
Wind from S. to S.W. @ 9 P.M. discharge the Pilot
Cutter hulk bearing S by E @ distance 3 miles.
@ Mid night Roman's Land bore about East.
Gay Head @ 2 A.M. bore N.E. distance 12 miles
@ Double reef the Fore top sail. Day light made sail
steering to the S.E. saw 2 Ships steering to the South.
Employ^d stowing the Anchors and other Jobs.
Moon Late 40-49. Lon 70-27 1/2.
- 3 Saturday 4th Employ^d in ship's duty steering
to the S.E. @ 4 P.M. headed to the E.S.E. by the
Wind. @ 1 P.M. the Trawl haul to the Westward steering
to the S.E. @ 10 A.M. passed a barque steering to the
East. Later Part employed in ship's duty
fitting boats. Moon Late 33. 45 Long 68.
- 4 Sunday 5th First Part steering to the South and
East Employ^d fitting boats and other Jobs Middle
Part Abateat breeze from S.W. headed S.E.
Later Part Squally with rain @ 10 A.M. left off
East. Moon Late 39. 53. N. Long 66. 28 1/2.
- 5 Monday 6th First Part of these 24 hours. Steering
to the East all hands at Leisure. Middle Part
Light breeze from the Westward Later Part Wind hauling
to the N.E. Employ^d in ship's duty saw 3 Sails.
Moon Late 39. 42. N. Long 64. 30 1/2.
