

Remarks on Board Barque Corca. 1841.

6 Tuesday Sept 7th. Commenced with moderate breeze from the North with rain & sails in sight at 6 p.m. wind bore to the N.E. steering E.S.E. both the wind with passing rain spoke employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part light breeze and calm. With passing Thunder squalls. at 2 A.M. Light breeze from the North. Latter part light breeze from N.E. to S.E. headed from E. to S.E. Hands employ^d in ship's duty.
 Noon Lat^d 39-02 N Long 67-57 W

7 Wednesday 8th. Commenced with light breeze from the S. took ship to the East employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part light breeze from S.W. with distant Thunder. Latter part light breeze and variable headed to the East employ^d in ship's duty.
 Noon Lat^d 40-02 N Long 60-46 W

8 Thursday 9th. Commenced with light breeze from the N.W. headed to the Eastward at 6 p.m. Light breeze from S.W. hands employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part moderate breeze from S.W. steering E. Latter part light breeze and variable with rain and distant Thunder employ^d in ship's duty.
 Noon Lat^d 40-17 N Long 59-26 W

9 Friday 10th. Commenced with light breeze and variable headed to the Eastward saw a sail to the South west employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering E.S.E. Latter part the same with rain.
 Noon Lat^d 41-23 N Long 51-43 W

10 Saturday 11th. Commenced with light breeze steering E.S.E. saw a sail steering to the E.N.E. employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part squally steering E.S.E. Latter part moderate breeze sail in sight.
 Noon Lat^d 40-36 N Long 53-38 W

Remarks on Board the Barque Corca. Sept 1841.

11 Sunday Sept 12th 1841. Commenced with moderate breeze from the South steering E.S.E. at 6 p.m. wind haul^d to S.E. - steering by the Wind to E.S.E. hands employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part pleasant Latter part the same saw a sail steering to the N.W. saw grass pines
 Noon Lat^d 40-23 N Long 57-15 W

12 Monday 13th. Commenced with moderate breeze from the S. steering E.S.E. Middle part strong breeze from S.W. steering E.S.E. Latter part light breeze saw a frigate steering to the Eastward also saw spouts from a wreck saw no more of them employ^d in ship's duty.
 Noon Lat^d 39-57 N Long 48-53 W

13 Tuesday 14th. Commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather at 4 p.m. lowered the Tents to try the Crew - struck and saved a sile fish. put the Cook in the Mizen Rigging for getting drunk Middle part the same Latter part the same
 Noon Lat^d 40-44 N Long 47-48 W

14 Wednesday 15th. Commenced with light breeze and calm headed to the E.S.E. hands employ^d in ship's duty. Middle part light breeze from S.W. and pleasant at 6 A.M. lowered the Tents for black fish the Starboard boat struck and tilted two the Larboard boat one. at 8 A.M. got them along side and hoisted them on board. commenced with light breeze and pleasant weather steering E.S.E.
 Noon Lat^d 40-21 N Long 46-06 W
