87 Tuesday March 18th Commenced with strong trades and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. boiled out the blubber made about 3 lbs Mince and later parts the same

90 Wednesday 19th Commenced with fresh trades and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. Employed in ships duty

Now Lat^o 16. 50 N. Long^o 48. 06 W.

91 Thursday 20th Commenced with moderate breezes and fine weather. Mince and later part the same daylight saw a Steam Boat steering to the Westward

Now Lat^o 18. 32 N. Long^o 49. 15 W.

92 Friday 21st Commenced with Light Trades and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. Employed in painting the parts at 11 P.M.

Now Lat^o 19. 51 N. Long^o 50. 10 W.

93 Saturday 22nd Commenced with Light trades and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. Employed cleaning ship and painting parts.

Now Lat^o 20. 43 N. Long^o 51. 53 W.

The first part of this day, or Friday being accounted at 11 P.M. Mr. Scott brought in to the world of care a male child in birth, and 2 deaths. The last her husband and child on board.

Sunday 23rd Commenced with Light trades and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. Employed in painting the parts at 11 P.M. Mr. Scott very low she has got a fever upon her.

Monday March 24th Commenced with Light breezes and pleasant steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later moderate breeze. Employed in painting the parts at 11 P.M. Mr. Scott rather better.

Now Lat^o 22. 18 N. Long^o 53. 27. 45 W.

Tuesday March 25th Commenced with Light breeze from N.E. to E. saw 2 sails steering S.W. Mince part the same. Later part rain equal. Mr. Scott doing well as the 24th.

Now Lat^o 23. 25 N. Long^o 54. 03. 25 W.

94 Wednesday March 26th Commenced with Light breeze from N.E. to E. Mince and later parts light air and calm. Saw a brig steering to the Westward.

Now Lat^o 23. 55 N. Long^o 54. 47. 10 W.

Thursday March 27th Commenced with Light breezes and variable from S. to S.W. Mince part the same. Later part fresh breeze with calm from S. to N.E. (with rain) at 11 P.M. in light to the S.W.

Now Lat^o 25. 00 N. Long^o 56. 00 W.

Friday March 28th Commenced with strong breeze and heavy steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. social

Now Lat^o 25. 50 N. Long^o 56. 00 W.

Saturday March 29th Commenced with strong breeze and heavy steering. At 11 P.M. Mince and later parts the same. steering N.W. by N. a ship steering to the West.

Now Lat^o 27. 31 N. Long^o 57. 45. 15 W.
