 Anticosti bearing N by E dist 25 miles & 5<sup>th</sup> bell heaved  
 to the S.W. by the wind. Misses part. heaved to the N.W.  
 & 9<sup>th</sup> bell saw Chatham bearing W. steering N.W. & 10<sup>th</sup> bell kept in  
 of N.W. & 8<sup>th</sup> bell about 1<sup>st</sup> saw Cook's steering N.W. 1<sup>st</sup> bell in  
 sight and plenty of Humpbacks & 7<sup>th</sup> bell the wind ran  
 to N.W. by N. & heaved to N.W. & 12<sup>th</sup> heaved to the West.

Monday April 14<sup>th</sup> Commenced with strong breezes from  
 heading N.W. by E. & 3<sup>rd</sup> saw the Cape Light and Race Point  
 & 4<sup>th</sup> bell tack in shore. Plymouth Light & 11<sup>th</sup> bell bore by  
 Comrap. N.W.
