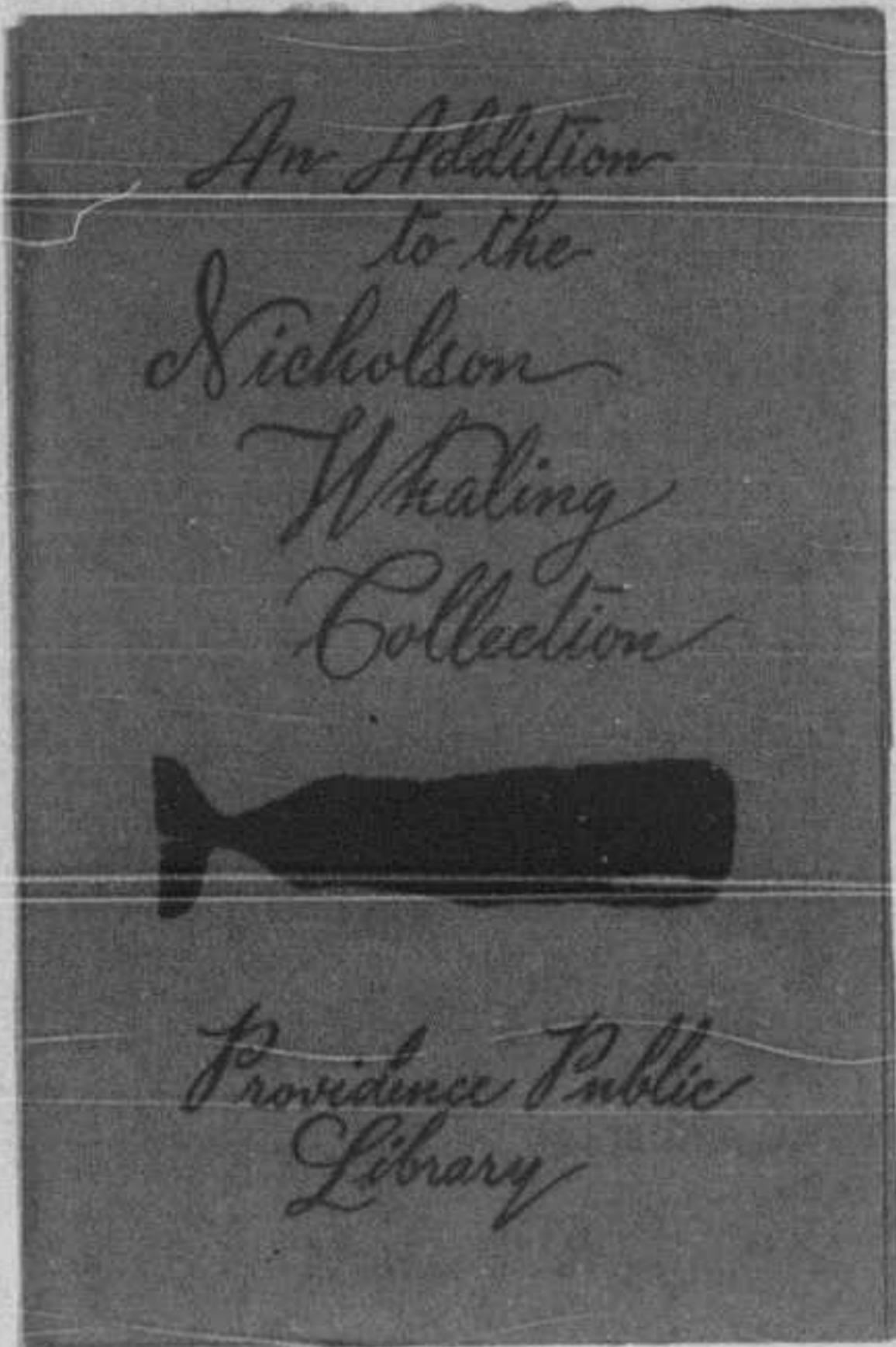

BINDER'S NOTE

Author:
Title: Corinthian Accounts
Place and date: 1829

Condition when received: This account book had been made into a child's scrapbook. All entries obliterated by clippings and crayon scribbling. Paper acid and stained. Covers badly damaged and leather rotted.

Work performed: Disassembled. Soaked off clippings and paste with hot water. Removed most of crayon marks with solvents. Washed paper, deacidified and sized with gelatin. Rebound in new boards, English goatskin and mulberry paper. Replaced remnants of original marbled paper sides and original leather label on front cover. Salvaged "alphabet to ship balance acct." paste to inside rear cover. Signed George M. Cunha Oct. 29 19 66
