Wednesday July 9th 1856

Took our anchor at New London
and with all hands on board
and the ship in charge of the
Pilot proceeded down the river
at 2 P M passed Montauk point
and discharged Pilot soon after
Captain learned that he had
forgotten his charts made signal
for the Pilot boat She returned
put the Captain and crew on
her and received the Pilot on board
of the ship. Made part the
ship saying adieu off the Point
latter part a light breeze blew
the S. E. at 4.30 M Captain
returned again on board set all
sail and steered S. E. by E.
bound for the Cape de Verdes
islands
