Friday March 26th

Comes in calm cloudy weather
middle part the same latter
part light air from various quarters
with rain squalls so ends the day

Lat by Ob 27:20 Long by Chr 62:00

Saturday March 27th

Comes in with a light air from
SW and hauls to W with rain
steering by the wind all sail set
at 3. Bleeding on took in top gallant
sails at dark single reef the
top sails wing hauls to the NW
heading at 4. W and at 8 P.M.
set the main top gallant sails
over single reef top sail middle
heading at 4. W latter part heading
off N.W. & took ship heading N.S.W.
on the other tack at meridian
heading W by N all sail set by the
wind saw two sail standing to
the Eastward Lat 28:45 Long 63:00

Sunday March 28th 1858

Begins with light breeze from
NW pleasant steering by the
wind all sail set middle part
the same latter part almost a calm
a light air sprang up at 11 o'clock
from the E and hauls to the S.E.
steering W.N.W all drawing sail
set saw one sail

Monday March 29th

Comes in with a moderate breeze
from the S.W. middle part hauls to
further to the W. strong breeze steering
W.N.W all sail set latter part wind
haul to the W. pleasant steering by
the wind heading N.W. all sail
set saw two sail steering to the South
ward so ends

Tuesday March 30th

Comes in a fresh breeze from the W.
by N. heading N by W by the wind all
sail set saw one sail at 8 o'clock
took a squall from the N.E. & took in
light sails single reefed the top sails
took middle part set top gallant sail
over single reef top sails heading W.N.W
latter part blowing on strong from
NW took in top gallant sail
and flying jib heading W by S. at 8
P.M. double the top sails day ends with
a fresh breeze and pleasant

Lat 29:58 Long 68:20

Wednesday March 31st

Comes in with a fresh breeze from
the W. by N. W. pleasant steering
by the wind set and courses middle part
top sails set and courses middle part
double top sails latter part moderate
set all sail steering by the wind
heading W.N.W one sail in sight
standing to the W. day ends with
a light breeze from the N.E. steering
N.W.
