Thursday April 1st 1858

Comes in light breeze from
S E. pleasant steering N W.
all sail set mid ab part fresh
breeze latter part a moderate
gale steering N W with all prudent
sail set so Ends the day

Friday April 2nd

Comes in with a gale from S E
with rain steering N W at 3.
a m took in top gallant sails
at 7 hove her to under close reef
Main top sail blowing a heavy gale
mid ab part blowing heavy with bad
sea running oil between decks got
a drift choked it as well as we
could latter part still blowing
heavy Employed chocking oil
oil leaking bad Day Ends with
a heavy gale and bad sea

Lat by calculation 32:40 Long ^{by obs} 72:31

Saturday April 3rd

Comes in with a gale from S E
Cloudy weather laying to at 4.
gale moderating made double reef
top steering N E at 8 set all
sail steering N W mid ab part
wind light with a bad sea on
latter part calm with rain saw
one sail Employed chocking oil
between decks oil leaking badly
owing to the shrinking Day Ends
with a light breeze from the W

Sunday April 4th

Comes in with a light breeze from
S W pleasant steering N W all sail set
Employed chocking oil on sail sight
mid ab part light air from
the eastward latter part a fresh
breeze from the N E pleasant
steering by the wind under double
reef top sails fit and courses
Spoke Bark William Henry warren
young Master bound for Naramua
boarded her and bought barrel of
Flour one of bread on other sail
in sight at Meridian wind N E
heading N W by the wind under reef top
sails so Ends the 24 hours

Monday April 5th

This day Comes in with the wind
N E pleasant steering by the
wind heading N W under
double reef top sails one sail
in sight bound to the Westward
mid ab part light breeze from
S E latter part wind fresh and
dead ahead as it came down here the
Ship is in the South Edge of the Gulf
Stream and here she is left to be
heading N E and N E but I bear
it with Christian fortitude Day Ends
with a moderate breeze and pleasant
