Tuesday April 6<sup>th</sup>

by the wind heading N. E. more  
Ship a number of times saw  
two sail

Wednesday April 7<sup>th</sup>

Come in with a fresh breeze  
from N. N. W. pleasant steering  
by the wind heading N. E. under  
double reef top sail fit and courses  
at 8 A.M. took in fore and mizen  
top sails fit and main sail blowing  
a gale Middle part more moderate set fore  
and mizen top sails heading N. by N.  
Starboard tack aboard latter part  
being wind from N. by W. blowing  
a moderate gale at 5 P.M. were  
Ship heading N. E. by E. Starboard  
tack aboard one sail in sight  
I hope we shall get a fair wind soon  
if we do not we shall be very short  
of food

Thursday April 8<sup>th</sup>

Commences with the wind from  
N. N. W. pleasant steering by the  
wind heading N. E. by N. Middle  
part moderate set double reef  
top sails fit and main sail.  
latter part light airs from Northward  
pleasant spoke Ship Garland  
New Bedford Parsons Master 800  
Spinn got bread from her  
saw one other sail
