paper acid and stained and crumbling from heavy oil  
stains on upper edge.

Disassembled and consolidated crumbling  
paper with soluble nylon. Washed out  
residual grease and stains with pyradine, clear gasoline  
and hot water. Deacidified. Mended and guarded and re-  
bound in new boards, best English calfskin and mulberry  
paper sides. Replaced remnants of original marbled sides  
original end papers and labels.
