

Schooner Adelia Chase Log Book.
commenced, Wednesday Oct 30th 1901.

Said Chase start from Marcell's wharf at noon. She was towed out to sea by tug S.C. Hart. at 4 P.M. we made sail and proceed to sea under command of. Alfred Lenna for Whaling Voyage in North Atlantic Ocean and crew of 14 persons. Vessel drawing 20 feet Water after, and well found in every respect and stank with her pumps in good order at 5 P.M. Roman land bearing N East 10 miles off. with S. took my defective wind light from S. West at sails set on Starboard tack heading S. by East. we unbind chains and turn them down pumps tried and good lookout kept thru the night saw ends this day.

Thursday Oct 31st 1901.

First part of this day came in with calm weather. Roman land in sight at noon Spring up little breeze from the South. Scho on Starboard tack heading S. by East - all sails set. Crew employed rigging up boats and pumps attend to no leak. latter part very light wind. lots Steamer going N. West. no observations. Heavy apt in atmosphere.
