

Ship Courier on her Passage to Cape Verde

Monday October 7th

Latter part fresh from N^W and clear & Am
weighed anchor made all sail Course S^W by W.
all hands employed in towing anchor 98
Lat 44²⁰ Long 00⁰⁰, 00

Thursday October 8th

Fresh from the N^W and clear steering S^W N^W
with all sail set at 2 pm finished stowing our anchors
cleared up the decks and getting ready for Weathering
at 7 pm all hands chose the masts and took in
the light sails our sby & middle stuns from the
north course the same later fine course S^E
Lat 39²⁰ Long 68⁵⁰, 30

Wednesday October 9th

Fine from the N^W course S^E & employed in fitting
Boats and preparing for staling middle the same
Latter fine winds N^W steering S^E & employed
in fitting Boats 2 sails in sight
Lat 36⁴⁵ Long 67¹⁵, 15

Thursday October 10th

Fine and pleasant steering S^E & employed in fitting
Boats our sail in sight middle air from the
N^W with rain latter fine from the S^E & course
S^E with all sail set one Brig in sight
Lat 37¹⁰ Long 65⁴⁰, 30

Friday October 11th

Strong from the N^E and clear course S^E by S nothing
in sight middle strong took in the topgallant
Latter fine Lat 34³⁵ 63⁴⁵ 50
