 Remarks on Board Friday April 6<sup>th</sup>  
 At 7 am took our anchor and run out of the bay  
 With wind at NNE at 4 pm ran on land bore  
 ENE distant 15 miles from which we took our  
 departure so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday April 7<sup>th</sup>  
 This 24 hours light winds at NE with pleasant weather  
 at midnight past a bark steering to NW our course  
 is SSW Lat 39 = 58 North  
 Long 71 = 51 West

Remarks on Board Sunday April 8<sup>th</sup>  
 first part of this 24 hours calm with pleasant weather  
 middle part light breeze from SSE and pleasant  
 latter part strong breeze with rain at 8 am took in  
 flying jib and reefed the mainsail at 6 am saw  
 finbacks so ends this day No other course seen

Remarks on Board Monday 9<sup>th</sup>  
 first of this 24 hours blowing strong at South with rain  
 at 4 pm split jib and foresail took in mainsail and  
 set staysail schr by the wind heading SE middle part  
 same latter part more moderate employed bending the  
 till and foresail No other

Remarks on Board Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>  
 first of this 24 hours thick weather with light wind and heavy  
 sea from SW at 8 am wind from NE strong with foggy  
 weather the schr under storm sails steering S by W  
 middle part the same latter part more moderate  
 with weather foggy Lat 37 = 48 North  
 Long 74 = 6 West
