Wednesday Sep 26<sup>th</sup>

This day came in with like air  
and calm still working off shore  
and to the S.W. this day employed  
in rigging boats and doing other  
ships duty.

Thursday Sep 27<sup>th</sup>

This day came in with like air from  
S. at 9am hauled S.W. 1 PM hauled  
N. squared in and steering S to 1:30 PM  
took in manual and flying jib  
stowed the cables below and doing  
other ships work so and this day  
raining and thick

Friday Sep 28<sup>th</sup>

This day came in with the wind from  
the N.W. steering S to 3 PM  
took in the outer jib and  
employed in rigging the boats  
and putting the mast head  
up down moderate so and
